## Remarks

1. Items with asterisks (\*) are for Camping Merit Badge and Outback Programs.
2. Items with two asterisks (\*\*) are for Swimming Merit Badge too.
3. Pack in a water proof footlocker or plastic storage bins that will fit under your bed at camp (max 16" high).
4. Label your things. Put daily change of T-shirt, underwear, socks in zip lock bags.
5. Leave electronic games at home, but a walkman is OK for the car ride. We'll store the walkman while in camp. Leave expensive items home so they don't get lost.
6. If you take PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION, you will need to have a permission slip and we'll notify camp medical personnel to store if necessary.
7. We'll have a Camp Bank to hold money for scouts.
